ESG Portfolio Management's two funds make the United Nations' 17 Sustainable Development Goals into their investment program - ahead of many other, even large, houses is the integration of the EU regulatory framework, in particular the taxonomy with already very high alignment ratios. Also, the 2° target is already met.

The monthly transparent reports are very comprehensive and deserve best practice status.

His work - one could almost say missionary work - on sustainability in investment has been exemplary for years and is now honored with the Boutiques Award for Sustainability.
